**Curriculum**: We anticipate having two different types of workshops: one for beginners and one for

more advanced administrators. The granularity and selection of a sub-set of topics (from a broad topic list provided by Vanderbilt REDCap) is determined by registrants. Registrants are given topics to rank and time is allocated to the topics most highly ranked.

**Structure**: Half of the day is a high-level overview, presented lecture-style. The second half is more hands-on and involves small group discussions.

**Presenters**: Vanderbilt staff and faculty as well as guest speakers from other Consortium institutions.
